Applicants must be juniors, seniors, or graduate students majoring in Communication with at least 12 completed credits. Applicants must have an overall GPA above 3.0 and a major GPA above 3.25.

If you are interested in LPH membership, please print and return the attached application to faculty advisor, Dr. Jen Eden, by **Monday October 30, 2017**. Completed applications may be put in Dr Jen Eden's mailbox located in LT 249. We evaluate ONLY current (Fall 2017) complete applications, which include a handwritten signature, online teacher recommendation, and attached resume.

Incomplete applications will not be considered (i.e., missing signature, missing recommendation, wrong application, etc.). For the teacher recommendation, you may ask any communication faculty member (full time or adjunct) to complete the [online recommendation form](#). We will confirm your recommendation with the professor as a dishonest recommendation will disqualify you from the application process.

**What we look for in an applicant:**

- Dedication to and experience in the communication field outside of the classroom (ex. internship, volunteer work, job, club leadership etc.)
- Involvement on the Marist campus through organizations, sports, etc.
- A thorough, well-written, and error free application.
- Enthusiasm for communication inside and outside the classroom.

Applications for the 2017-2018 academic year will be open once per semester per academic year. Applicants accepted in the Fall 2017 semester will be inducted to Lambda Pi Eta in Spring 2018. If you are not accepted in the Fall 2017 semester you are encouraged to reapply in the Spring 2018 semester.

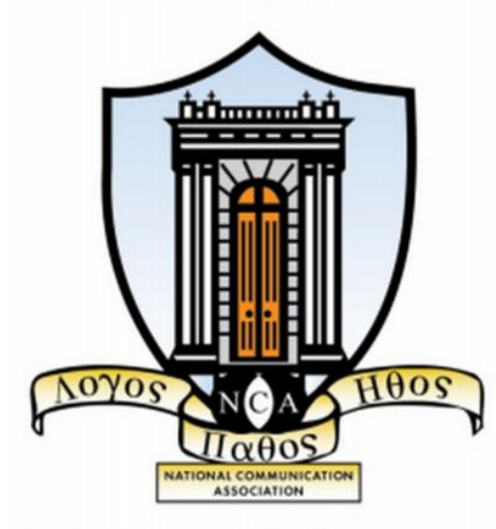
